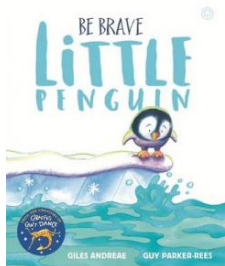
Story Diploma for families and groups
